### PRE-CONFERENCE INTENSIVE WORKSHOPS

On Sunday, October 31, 2010, ICCA will offer three or four intensive, day-long pre-conference workshops on a variety of topics. These workshops may involve a team of presenters, panel presentations, or be interactive with the audience.

### RESEARCH CONFERENCE WORKSHOPS

On Monday, November 1, through Wednesday noon, November 3, the ICCA Conference will feature commissioned keynote presentations of new research on various aspects of community corrections. The theme this year will emphasize the implementation of best practices and managing organizational change, but will also include correctional education, juvenile justice, transitional housing, employment, family reunification, restorative justice, and substance abuse and mental health treatment.

The array of workshops for which we are inviting your participation will demonstrate evidence-based best practices and promising practices at work in the field. **Workshops are typically 90 minutes in length**, with 5-6 workshops running concurrently following each plenary session. The format may be lecture, panel presentation, or interactive.

### AUDIENCE

The ICCA conference is the premiere international research conference on community corrections. Attendance for the Louisville conference is estimated at 500-600 community corrections agency leaders and program directors, probation and parole officers, jail reentry program directors, as well as researchers, students, government representatives, officers of the court, and vendors.

### PRESENTERS

Presenters are responsible for their own transportation and accommodation costs but will be offered free conference registration for the day of their presentation.
